The PRP outlines the plan the Township will use to reduce pollutants discharged from the Township storm sewer system within the Stony Creek, Sawmill Run, Plymouth Creek and Mermaid Run watersheds. The Township is soliciting for written comments on the PRP. Interested persons may submit written comments during the 45-day period of July 10 – August 24, 2017. The plan may be reviewed during the comment period at Whitpain Township Administration Offices, 960 Wentz Road, Blue Bell, PA 19422 weekdays from 8:30AM - 4:30PM or on the Township website (www.whitpaintownship.net). Improving Streams And Creeks

On July 13 at 7 p.m., the Township will host a forum to update residents on its Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) for several watersheds in the community including, Stony Creek, Sawmill Run, Plymouth Creek and Mermaid Run.

The meeting will be held at the Township Building at 960 Wentz Road. The requirement to prepare a plan is mandated by the state and will help improve our waterways by reducing the amount of sediment and nutrient pollutants within stormwater runoff.

The PRP will be available for public examination from July 10 to August 24 at the Township Building and on the Township's website.

Work Continues On Muhlenburg Drive

PECO crews are working to replace residential natural gas service lines on Muhlenburg Drive between Lafayette Way and Stirling Way.

The stretch of road continues to be intermittently closed to traffic during daytime work hours when crews are on the site. Residents, emergency vehicles, mail carriers, and trash haulers will have access to this area at all times.

PECO is expected to complete this work on or before July 17. This PECO work is being done in advance of the Township's road resurfacing operation.
