How it works

- A key to your residence will be stored in a metal storage device, similar to a Realtor's Lock Box.
- The box will be secured near the entrance to your residence.
- The access code will *only* be available to emergency personnel, and *only* during an emergency if they cannot gain entry to your home without using force.

Who is Eligible?

All Whitpain Township residents, age 55 and older, or younger disabled persons, who live alone and/or have major medical issues.

Note: Exceptions to the above requirements will be considered on a case by case basis. If you feel you would benefit from the program, please apply.

How do I know this is safe?

An officer in full uniform will install and demonstrate how the lock operates and will answer any questions you may have.
