ORDINANCE NO. 389

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WHITPAIN, PART II (GENERAL LEGISLATION), CHAPTER 142
(VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), SECTION 142-12 (TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT
CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS) AT SUBSECTION A**

The Board of Supervisors of Whitpain Township does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN**:

SECTION I. – Amendment to the Code

The Code of the Township of Whitpain, Part II (General Legislation), Chapter 142 (Vehicles and Traffic), Section 142-12 (Traffic Signals at Certain Intersections) is amended to include the following traffic signals:

§ 142-12. Traffic Signals at certain intersections.

A. At the following locations, traffic signals as indicated below shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected), and traffic at those locations shall be directed by those signals:

Name of Highway	Intersecting Road(s)
Morris Road	Montgomery County Community College (North Entrance)
Skippack Pike	Centre Square Fire Company & Centre Square Plaza Access Driveway
DeKalb Pike	Centre Square Commons & WAWA driveway

SECTION II. - Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections,

sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III. - Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION IV. - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.

SECTION V. - Repealer

All other ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
